STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE & MANAGEMENT

The Charity was established in 1998 and is governed by, and in accordance with, its constitution. The Trustees of the Charity are currently as listed above. Selection was by way of personal approach to the volunteers.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The objects of the Charity are to raise funds to help young instrumental musicians in the Perth & Kinross area. The policies adopted in the furtherance of these objects are to obtain grant funding (where possible), and to organise fund raising events. There have been no changes to these policies during the reporting year.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

Fund raising events generated £2,476 (2017 £5,548). These consisted of one concert (£760), a Quiz Night (£558), and the remaining income in 2017/18 is the balance of sponsorship monies from a Sponsored Abseil undertaken in May 2017 but not received in the last reporting year (£1,158).

Donations amounted to £12,192 (2017 £9,929). No donations were received in the reporting year from any other Charity/Charitable Trust (2017 £7,000). During the year, grants totalling £16,845 (2017 11,078) were paid out to applicants.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The net outgoing resources for the year ended 30 June 2018 were £2,889 (2017 incoming £5,082).

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF PERTH & KINROSS MUSIC FOUNDATION

I have examined the Management Committee's report, the Charity's accounting records, the Receipts and Payments Account, the Statement of Balances, and the attached notes for the year ended 30 June 2018, of Perth & Kinross Music Foundation (Charity Number SCO 27457) as set on pages 3 to 7 of this report.

RESPECTIVE RESPONSIBILITIES OF TRUSTEES AND EXAMINER

The Charity's Trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) 2005 Act, and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The Charity Trustees consider that the audit requirements of Regulation 10(1) (a-c) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as prepared under section 44(1)(C) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

BASIS OF INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. This examination included a review of the accounting records kept by the Charity, and a comparison of the accounts presented from those records. I also included consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and sought explanations from the Trustees concerning such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently, no opinion is given as to whether these accounts present a "true and fair view", and this report is limited only to those matters set out in the statements below.
